



QUAIL RUN PARK

In northwest Stayton, between Eagle Street and Meadowlark Drive, this neighborhood park includes a half basketball court, playground, backstop for informal baseball play, benches, horseshoe pit, and a paved interior pathway.



WILDLIFE MEADOWS PARK

Located at the north end of Deer Avenue within Wildlife Meadows Subdivision, the park offers a green space and a paved trail.



SANTIAM PARK

Located on the corner of Third Avenue and Wildflower Drive, this Stayton park features a picnic shelter, play area, walking and bike trails along the picturesque Mill Creek.




NORTHSLOPE PARK

In the northeast portion of Stayton, off Fern Ridge Road at the east end of Dawn Drive, this park has children's play areas, a half basketball court and a shaded picnic area.



WESTOWN PARK

In West Stayton on Westpark Court, this park features play areas, a half-court basketball court, two picnic tables, and a drinking fountain.

COMMUNITY CENTER PARK

Located behind the Stayton Public Library off of First Avenue. This park features a children's playground, tennis court and 1/2 basketball court, and a paved pathway along the Salem Ditch.



PIONEER PARK

Located off Seventh Avenue and Marion Street, Pioneer Park features play equipment, a disc golf course, an open grassy area, interior path system, picnic shelters, and the beautiful Jordan Bridge. The concession stand and Bridge are available to rent.



RIVERFRONT PARK

Following along the banks of the beautiful North Santiam River, this Stayton park is 55 acres of undeveloped land. Accessed by a pedestrian bridge from East Florence Street, the park provides opportunities for hiking, fishing, and walking your favorite canine companion.



HENRY A. PORTER DOG PARK

Located at 180 N Fourth Avenue, your pup can play off leash in this fenced, tree studded park. There's water for thirsty dogs along with benches and a picnic table for people to sit and watch the fun.


