Director's Report

- a. Library Services update
 - We collected over 340 pounds of food for the Stayton Food Bank and Santiam Hospital in November. In addition, more than 1,000 stubs were collected, so Library staff donated 40 additional food items.
 - Thank you to Hiatt Christmas Trees for donating the greens for our Wreath Lab! We had 216 people come make wreaths, and we sent Jennifer and Anna on a trip to get more greens about halfway through the program because we were already running out.
 - We will light up the Library and part of the park behind us to music at our Hygge in the Dark program on Friday. It will also be the kickoff of our Winter Reading program.
- b. New member recruitment – Allison Gladney
 - Allison Gladney was appointed to the Library Board by the City Council on Monday. We are excited to welcome her to the Board at our January meeting.

General Business

- a. Friends of the Library Report
 - The Friends of the Library have purchased 40 eight-foot tables and 10 six-foot tables, so they will not have to borrow tables and coordinate moving the trailer of them for future book sales. Laurie has reorganized the container, and it is all set up and ready for the tables to be delivered.
- b. Foundation Report
 - The Stayton Public Library Foundation has been writing grants to raise the funds needed to paint the interior of the Library. It has not been painted since 2007 and is showing significant wear and tear. The Foundation had received a ballpark cost for painting of \$50,000 last spring. Since then, they have received \$15,000 from the Oregon Community Foundation, \$4,000 from Pacific Power, and a private donation of \$5,000. Fitzpatrick Painting reached out to the Foundation and offered a proposal reflecting their winter work pricing. The new estimate is within the Foundation's budget, and last Thursday the Foundation voted to sign the contract. We have a meeting with Fitzpatrick on Monday to discuss a couple of questions and talk about scheduling.

- We are working with the Foundation on a catwalk fundraiser called Inked scheduled for Saturday, February 28.
