Director's Report

- a. Library Services update
 - We had 560 people participate in Library March Madness. We had a variety of basketball-related challenges and games, along with brackets with picture books and early readers to vote on to see which books made it to the top. It was also a great way for the Library to support the City's Spring Break Adventure Log.
 - STEAM Days for April was Cloud Dough, and we had 145 people come make it with us.
 - The Oregon Library Association Conference is happening next week in Portland, and Anna and Emily expressed interest in going. Jennifer and Janna will go with them for the day on Thursday.
 - Jennifer and Janna are planning the framework and logistics for Summer Reading. We are looking for farm equipment to do a Farm-style Big Rig Roundup at the Kickoff party on June 16. Discussed ideas for farms and school connections for us to reach out to.
