In December, we had a great crowd for our shake-it-up storytime week, which is a special storytime that Jennifer adds hands-on activity stations to reinforce the concepts they've been exploring at Storytime. We want to shout out Republic Services, SCTC and Stayton Public Works for helping bring our construction rhymes to life with real trucks!

We had 112 people join us for Hygge in the Dark as we lit the Library with music and lights. Thank you to Denise, Eileen, Korin, Laurie, Nicolas, Katie, Brandon, and Julia for helping us light up the Library! It also kicked off our Winter Reading Challenge. We are encouraging people of all ages to engage in a Hygge (hoo-gah) inspired lifestyle, with opportunities to explore different aspects of a lifestyle beloved by one of the happiest countries in the world. To play, they are tracking activities in categories of their choice (Read - Make - Health - Nature - Connect - Focus). When they complete three activities in that category, they bring the form back to the Library. We are planning a Viking Fest at the end of January, inspired by the balanced activities we have worked on throughout the challenge.

We opened our STEAM Lab every day after school for a week, for an hour, and children of all ages explored the beginnings of coding with binary code bracelets and Code and Go robot mice. Anna led our Sippin' into a Social Hour program, this time focused on music, and Rachel hosted Fiber Arts Connection. Book club met to discuss Mother-Daughter Murder Night by Nina Simon.

Jennifer and Janna provided free books to all children at Stayton Elementary School's caroling event. Evie hosted our Holiday Party, and all Library staff helped celebrate our volunteers, Friends of the Library, Library Board, and Library Foundation board members. Jennifer represented Stayton at the Polk, Yamhill and Marion (PYM) Children's Services meeting, and Janna represented Stayton at the PYM Library Directors meeting.
